In PH All Budgets Are Project Dependent
Choices Matter!
Using Modeling for Value Engineering
Smaller Premium for PH in New Construction
Smaller Buildings Pay a Higher Premium High as10%
Smaller Buildings Consider Renewables Before Additional Insulation
In Remodels Be Careful About Switching Fuel Types
In Retrofits It is Cheaper to Insulate from the Outside
