



Wind Energy in the Classroom Teacher Training Workshop

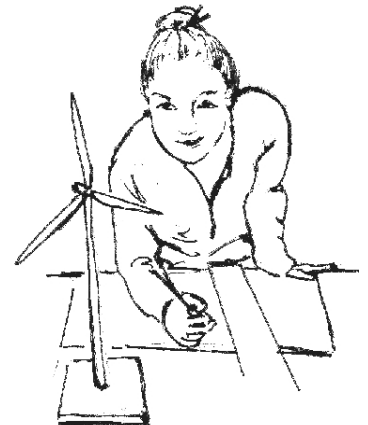
