

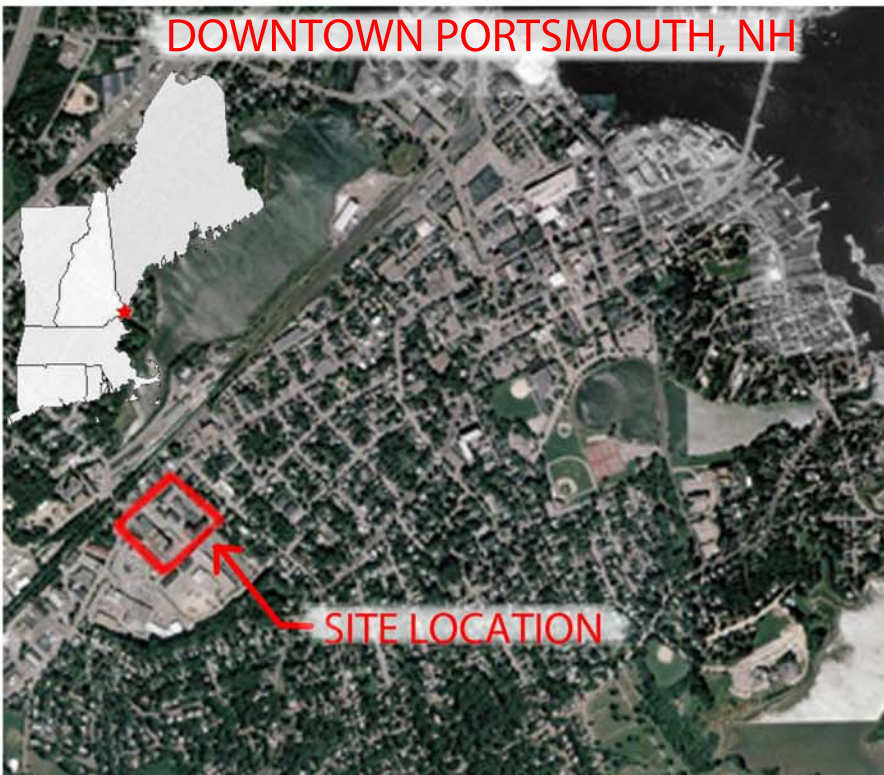
NESEA Building Energy 2010 - Frank Jones Brewery Student Design Competition



The 2010 NESEA Student Design Competition Committee is currently seeking students to participate in this year's Building Energy 2010 student design competition. The competition will promote the development of progressive, energy efficient, aesthetically pleasing and sustainable designs.

Located in Portsmouth, New Hampshire is the site of the once prominent Frank Jones Brewery, New England's largest brewery prior to prohibition. The competition will be focused on the revamp of one of its large, abandoned 19th century buildings as well as the design of a new annex. The objective is to create energy efficient housing units and commercial spaces that do not sacrifice on aesthetics, occupant comfort or affordability.
