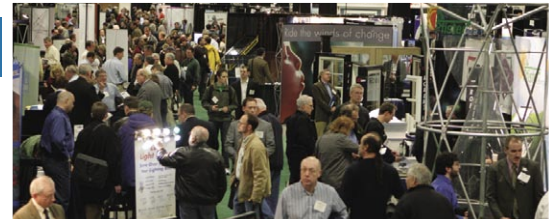

- The **GREENFIELD ENERGY PARK**

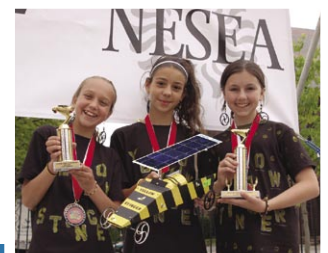
